

We are pleased to tell you that at the CHE National Council meeting in Preston on the 18th. June the Eastbourne CHE group received formal recognition. Six members of our group took part in this year's Gay Pride march in London on June 25th. The 2,000 strong procession started from Temple Place, near Holborn, winding its way through central London and drawing the attention of thousands of tourists and residents, to end in a picnic in Hyde Park. We were accompanied by some members of the Tunbridge Wells group who kindly lent us some banners.

Our day trip to Beaulieu is going ahead as planned on July 16th. Those of us who are going will wish to note the following arrangements.
